

Dr. Andrew S. Rosenson is a healthcare entrepreneur and founder of Maxwell Telecare, providing clinical telemedicine care to the senior care community. He is a national expert in utilization management and outcomes analysis with special expertise in clinical operations and pharmacy cost controls. Dr. Rosenson is the Chief Medical Officer for a national healthcare consulting firm specializing in strategic cost reduction and revenue stream innovation. In the clinical realm, he is also a pioneer and leading expert in diagnostic imaging of the coronary arteries. Dr. Rosenson has published numerous articles, lectured at national conferences, and has appeared nationally on The Oprah Winfrey show, as well as other television and radio appearances.

Originally board certified as a primary care physician by the American Board of Pediatrics, Dr. Rosenson is a Fellow of the American Academy of Pediatrics and is board certified by the American Board of Nuclear Medicine, the American Board of Radiology, and the Certification Board of the Society of Cardiovascular Computed Tomography. He has held faculty appointments in Preventive Medicine at the Northwestern University Medical School and in the Department of Medicine at University of Chicago Medical School.
